





# About Tenerife

The Canary Islands are a volcanic archipelago, the southernmost autonomous community of Spain. Located in the Atlantic Ocean. There are approximately 2 million people living in the Canary Islands at present.



The archipelago is composed by seven main islands and several islets. They are split in two provinces, which you can see on the map. The autonomous community of the Canary Islands has a shared capital by the cities of Santa Cruz de Tenerife and Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.

In the Canary Islands summers are pleasant (19-28°C) and very mild winters (15-20°C). An eternal spring of sunny days, blue skies and stable temperatures, without great oscillations throughout the year.

The islands have a different time zone than the Spanish peninsula, in the Canaries there's an hour less than in the mainland.



# Fun Facts

- 1. Tenerife is the largest island in the archipelago and the only one that has two international airports.**
- 2. Tenerife is famous for its carnival, that usually takes place around February.**
- 3. The island is crowned by the highest peak in Spain - the Teide volcano, at 3,718 meters.**
- 4. Its cuisine includes goat cheese, goat meat, a large assortment of fish (samas, cherne, viejas, tuna, sardines etc.), the famous potato dish “papas arrugadas” and “gofio”, a toasted mix of ground grains.**
